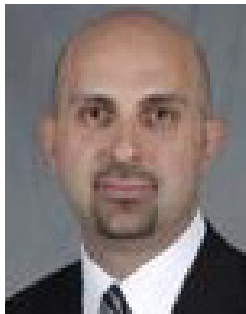

Finding a Healthcare Cure For Your Employees

The 30-Minute Marketing Plan - How to develop an “Inbound” Marketing Strategy

In just the past 10 years, marketers have received a whole new toolkit filled with things like Facebook, LinkedIn, Twitter, Yelp, smart phones, tablets, Craigslist.com and more. Digital marketing is essential to gaining your share of referrals. Most entrepreneurs have not changed their sales and marketing processes to keep up with this change in buyer behavior. 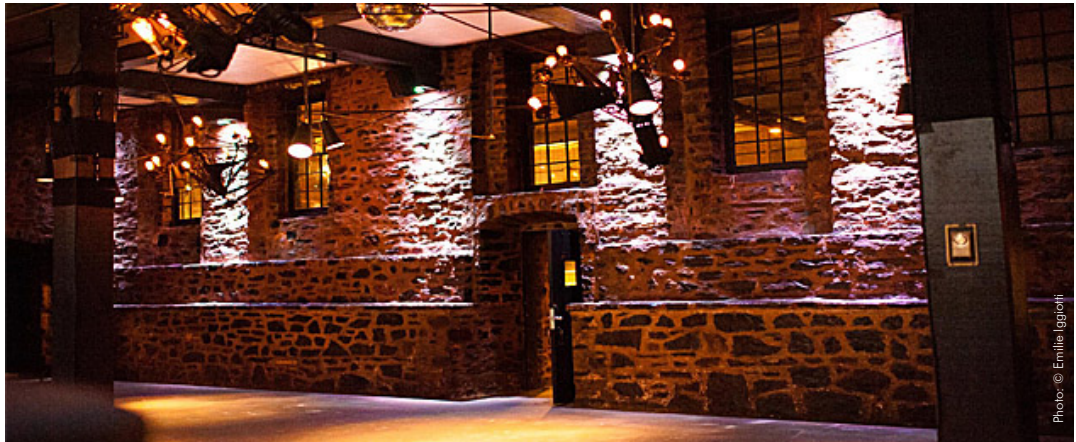

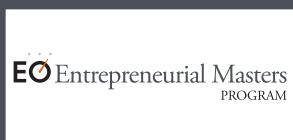
